#### THE CREATION OF THE EARTH

It was freezing in the first one, the other one was the world of fire and there was an abysa<sup>2</sup> in between of them. Then, the frost met fire and that's how a gaint called Ymi was created. #### THE GODS

The Gods from Norse mythology come The Gods from Norse mythology come from two groups – Assir and Vanir. The Assir live in Asgard but a lot of Vanir live there, too. The acovereign of all the gods is Odin. His wife is Frigg and they're the parents of Thor (the god of thunder, he's very strong and owns a magical hammer Mjölnir), Balder (the god of purity\* and forgiveness, the favourite of every god except Leki and tonge others. cept Loki) and some others

Loki is the god of trickery\* and later he becomes the enemy of the gods. Bragi is the god of poetry. From Vanir, there is Njöro' (the god of sea and wind) and his offspring\* Freyja (the goddess of love and beauty) and Freyr (the god of sunshine and light rain). Then there are
